\$3.5M Settlement in Bus Accident

Renda & Voynick obtained a \$3.5 million recovery for their clients. The case was handled by



Andrew J. Renda, Jr., involving a collision between a school bus and a truck, which occurred when the bus driver disregarded a red light. Renda & Voynick represented two children who were passengers on the school bus. The young boy sustained extensive and life threatening head injuries with multiple skull fractures, necessitating extensive neurosurgery. The traumatic brain injury resulted in cognitive deficits and impaired learning capabilities. The boy's sister sustained a concussion as well as emotional distress as a result of witnessing her brother's near death. During a second mediation hearing, Mr. Renda negotiated a settlement in which the boy's case was settled for \$3 million, and the girl's case was settled for \$500,000. The settlement was structured to arrange for

the payment of the settlement monies over time, resulting in a guaranteed payout as to the boy's claim in excess of \$12.6 million, and a guaranteed payout as to the girl's claim in excess of \$700,000.
